



2017 Official Need-Based Scholarship Application Guidelines

The Fraser Memorial Foundation is pleased to announce that its annual Need-Based Scholarships are now available to Secondary and High School students in Hayes and surrounding areas. Students with a Grade of C or above, excellent attendance record, extracurricular activities and community service experience may apply.

Important Information

Application will be considered incomplete if any of the application requirements are missing. An independent Distinguished Panel of Judges will review the application packages and determine the overall winner and finalists: **THE JUDGES' DECISION IS FINAL.**

Applicants will be judged on the following criteria: contribution to school life, academic achievement, extra-curricular achievement, community involvement and overall presentation of the portfolio submitted. **(Scholastic achievement solely does not guarantee placement in this Need-Based Scholarship Program.)**

All funds must be used for Secondary or High School education purposes only.

Applications are available to students with financial hardship from any public Secondary/High Schools in Hayes or surrounding areas, regardless of colour, creed, or religious affiliation.

The deadline for submission of completed application packages for the 2016-2017 Fraser Memorial Foundation Scholarships is Wednesday, May 31st, 2017 at 5:00PM. Fraser Memorial Foundation is not responsible for application packages which are late, lost, illegible, damaged, or incorrectly addressed. **All application packages submitted will become the property of Fraser Memorial Foundation and WILL NOT BE RETURNED.**

The Application Requirements

A **completed** application form

A 500-word essay on the topic: **"The Importance of Giving Back to My Community"**

The essay must be legible if handwritten in black or blue ink or typed.

Essay must be student's original work and must be free from plagiarism.

Current copies of official grades.

We require one high quality headshot **passport size photograph**. (This photograph is for the newspapers, website and awards banquet souvenir journal) Photographs will not be returned.

(Preferred choice of attire is school uniform)

If applicable, newspaper clippings/copies of awards and certificates.

Three (3) **letters of recommendation:**

School Principal/Vice Principal (the letter from the Principal or Vice Principal officially nominates the student for this scholarship)

Classroom teacher, civic community leader or former teacher;

Religious leader or extra-curricular coach (i.e., Sports, Speech, Dance etc.)

The above items should be neatly attached to a portfolio or folder.
